
Foundation Course for the Newly Recruited Officials of NCDC

Professional Leadership Development on Strengthening of Women Cooperatives




Strengthening Linkages between Primary Cooperatives and DCCBs


Safety Standards for Milk and Milk Products

Two Days Online Training Programs on Accounts and Book Keeping



मछली पालन को बढ़ावा देने के लिए राष्ट्रीय सहकारी विकास निगम हिमाचल प्रदेश शिमला के सौजन्य से दी हिम सहकारी मत्स्य किसान उत्पादक समूह मलांगड के अंतर्गत उपमंडल बंगाणा के दोहगी में मत्स्य पालन पर रविवार देर सायं एक दिवसीय जागरूकता शिविर का आयोजन किया गया। क्षेत्रीय निदेशक राकेश वर्मा ने मत्स्य पालकों को जानकारी देते हुए कहा कि लोग मत्स्य विभाग द्वारा चलाई जा रही योजनाओं का लाभ उठाएं। लोग मछली पालन से अपनी आर्थिक स्थिति को मजबूत करें। उन्होंने कहा कि सरकार द्वारा फिश फार्मिंग के लिए सामान्य वर्ग को ५० प्रतिशत अनुदान पर ७२२०० रुपये व अनुसूचित



जाति वर्ग के लोगों को ८६४०० रुपये उपलब्ध करवाए जा रहे हैं। पुराने तालाबों की मरम्मत व निर्माण के लिए प्रति हेक्टेयर अनुसूचित जाति वर्ग के लोगों को १२५०० रुपये व सामान्य वर्ग के लोगों को १०००० रुपये का अनुदान दिया जा रहा है। उन्होंने कहा कि आज के समय स्थानीय क्षेत्र में ही मछली की बिक्री हो जाती है इसलिए इसमें कार्य में काफी फायदा होता है। किसान भी इस कार्य को करके अतिरिक्त आमदनी हासिल कर सकते हैं। उन्होंने कहा कि कभी मत्स्य पालन मछुआरों तक

Three Years Three Records in Bihar

With a total release of Rs.4903 crore to Bihar during the last three financial years, i.e. 2019-20, 2020-21 and 2021-22, the NCDC has made its presence felt in the cooperative development of Bihar in an unprecedented manner. In fact, during these three financial years, the NCDC provided highest ever and record breaking assistance in comparison to the previous year's assistance. This is achieved due to the leadership and constant guidance of MD,NCDC as a result of which the RO Patna made all out efforts and succeeded in making inroads into the uncharted sector of providing financial assistance in a big way for paddy and wheat procurement by PACS in Bihar under MSP operations.

2. During the year 2019-20, an assistance of Rs.454.40 crore was

released for the cooperative projects in the State of Bihar which was highest ever assistance provided to Bihar in preceding years by the NCDC since its inception. In financial year 2020-21 alone total assistance reached to Rs.1633.60 crore. In FY 2021-22 an assistance of more than Rs.2815 crore has been provided by NCDC to Bihar which is highest ever. Since the inception of NCDC in March, 1963 and up to the year 2018-19, i.e. in 56 years, NCDC had provided a cumulative assistance of Rs.1703.41 crore to Bihar for cooperative development in the State. The prominent surge in NCDC's growth in Bihar during the recent years can be gauged from the fact that the assistance of Rs.2815 crore provided during a single year, i.e. 2021-22, is more than the cumulative assistance provided to Bihar in 56 years.

3. Cooperative sectors which have benefitted with NCDC assistance include PACS, ICDP, Dairy Development Projects through COMFED and Vaishal Patliputra Dairy Federation Ltd., Bihar State Cooperative Bank Ltd. to enable PACS in undertaking paddy and wheat procurement. These projects have benefitted entire cooperative movement in Bihar as all the 38 districts of Bihar have been covered.

4. For the next five years, RO Patna has drawn a roadmap for cooperative development in Bihar estimating that about Rs.15500 crore of releases are possible under procurement of food grains under MSP operations, farm mechanization hubs in all remaining potential PACS and implementing ICDP projects in remaining 16 districts of Bihar In addition, a state-wide

vegetable project, beekeeping project under National Beekeeping and Honey Mission, fishery project under Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana, Computerization of entire Bihar State Cooperative Bank are also possible as the RO Patna has held several rounds of discussions for these projects with the officers in concerned State Government Departments and the ground work has been completed. Further, a good amount of assistance is envisaged to be released for cold storages, consumer activities and Farmer and Fish Farmer Producer Organizations. NCDC, now has taken big leap in assisting the cooperatives in Bihar.
