HIGHLIGHTS APRIL 2023 – JUNE 2023

- NCDC has sanctioned and released financial assistance of ₹35701.52 Crore and ₹21811.33 Crore respectively during the 1st quarter of FY 2023-24.
- The 224th meeting of Board of Management, NCDC was held on 16 May, 2023.
- Setting up of Project Monitoring Unit (PMU):
As per the cabinet approval for setting up new multipurpose PACS/ dairy/ fishery primary cooperative societies covering all the panchayats/ villages in the country, NCDC was directed to set up a Project Management Unit (PMU) for real time monitoring of the formation of new cooperative societies. Accordingly, NCDC has awarded the work of PMU to M/s NABARD Consultancy Services Pvt. Ltd. (NABCONS) and the PMU has started its operation on 27.04.2023.
- World's Largest Grain Storage Project in Cooperative Sector:
Concerned Regional Directors of NCDC visited all 11 identified PACS in 11 districts of the Country selected for pilot implementation of World's Largest Grain Storage Project and Rs.22.00 lakh margin money assistance has been sanctioned to 1 PACS, namely, Paraswara Samiti (Balaghat, Madhya Pradesh).
- Annual Review Meeting (FY 2022-23) of the Regional Offices was conducted under chairmanship of the Managing Director from 18.04.2023 to 19.04.2023 to review their activities and performance. Secretary, Ministry of Cooperation and Chairman, BOM, NCDC attended the meeting as Chief Guest and congratulated entire NCDC team for achieving the highest ever disbursement in FY 2022-23.
- The Corporation participated in the National Cooperative Meet organized by the PHD Chamber of Commerce and Industry on 30 June 2023 and gave a brief presentation on the achievements of the Corporation.

HIGHLIGHTS OF MINISTRY OF COOPERATION

1. A one-time grant-in-aid of Rs.30 crore has been approved and released by the Ministry of Cooperation, Government of India to establish Vaikunth Mehta National Institute of Cooperative Management (VAMNICOM) as a Centre of Excellence for Cooperative Education and Training.
2. In order to realize the Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi's vision of "Sahkar se Samridhhi" and with the efforts of Union Home Minister and Minister of Cooperation Shri Amit Shah, a decision has been taken to form 1100 New Farmer Producer Organizations (FPOs) in Cooperative Sector. A target of these 1100 additional FPOs has been allocated to National Cooperative Development Corporation (NCDC) by the Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare under its 'Formation and Promotion of 10,000 FPOs' scheme. Integration of PACS in the FPO scheme will enable them to expand their business.
3. The Union Cabinet chaired by the Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi approved the constitution and empowerment of an Inter Ministerial Committee (IMC) for facilitation of the "World's Largest Grain Storage Plan in Cooperative Sector" by convergence of following various schemes of the Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare, Ministry of Consumer Affairs, Food and Public Distribution and Ministry of Food Processing Industries. Following schemes have been identified for convergence under the Plan:
 - a. Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare: Agriculture Infrastructure Fund (AIF), Agricultural Marketing Infrastructure Scheme (AMI), Mission for Integrated Development of Horticulture (MIDH), Sub Mission on Agricultural Mechanization (SMAM).
 - b. Ministry of Food Processing Industries: Pradhan Mantri Formalization of Micro Food Processing Enterprises Scheme (PMFME), Pradhan Mantri Kisan Sampada Yojana (PMKSY).
 - c. Ministry of Consumer Affairs, Food and Public Distribution: Allocation of food grains under the National Food Security Act, Procurement operations at Minimum Support Price.
4. It has been decided to allow 2000 Primary Agricultural Credit Societies (PACS) to open Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Jan Aushadhi Kendras across the country.

5. Four important initiatives have been taken to strengthen 1,514 Urban Cooperative Banks (UCBs) in the country:
 - a. In order to expand their business, Urban Cooperative Banks (UCBs) can now open new branches
 - b. UCBs can also do One Time Settlement at par with Commercial Banks
 - c. Revised timelines for PSL targets given to UCBs
 - d. Designating a Nodal Officer in RBI

ACTIVITIES OF LAXMANRAO INAMDAR NATIONAL ACADEMY FOR COOPERATIVE RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT (LINAC)

Project Formulation and Appraisal Techniques- 11-13 April, 2023 and 24-26 May, 2023

Two (2) three-day Online Training Programs on Project Formulation and Appraisal Techniques were successfully organized for 22 and 20 officials of NCDC respectively. These programs were organized to enable the participants to explain the concept of a project, how to formulate a project, elements involved in project formulation and different appraisal techniques used while formulating a project.

TECHNICAL APPRAISAL

Technical appraisal is carried out to assess the technical soundness of the project. It is mainly concerned with :

- ⊕ Project location and site
- ⊕ Layout, Structure and Civil Works
- ⊕ Production Technology
- ⊕ Production Capacity
- ⊕ Materials, Inputs and Consumables
- ⊕ Disposal of Effluents and Industrial Waste
- ⊕ Production Schedules and Costs

Developing Cooperatives as Agri-Exporters- 13 April, 2023 and 14 June, 2023

LINAC, jointly with Agriculture Produce Export Development Authority (APEDA), organized two (2) one-day online training programs on Developing Cooperatives as Agri-Exporters for personnel of Cooperative Societies. A total of 168 participants from cooperatives of Bihar and Jharkhand and 88 participants from cooperatives of Uttarakhand and Chhattisgarh participated in these training programs respectively.

HIGHLIGHTS OF EXPORT

1. India's share in global Agri export trade is **2.5%**.
2. India's Agri export contributes nearly **14.2% of its total merchandise exports**.
3. APEDA exports pertain to agri products (**\$19.96 bn**) in the year **2020-21 out of which, Cereals and Fresh horticulture 59%, Cereal preparations & Miscellaneous Processed items 23% and Animal products 18%**. (Source: DGCIIS).
4. Exports have taken place to more than 200 countries across the globe. Major export destinations include Saudi Arab, USA, UAE, Bangladesh, Hong Kong. Major products exported are Non Basmati Rice, Basmati Rice, Buffalo Meat, Groundnuts, Maize etc.
2. During 2020-21, export of Organic products was 1040 USD mn (888,179 MT).

Understanding and Interpretation of Financial Statements- 26-28 April, 2023

A three-day Online Training Program on Understanding and Interpretation of Financial Statements was successfully conducted for 22 officials of NCDC. The main objective of this training program was to acquaint the participants with the concept and techniques of financial statements, their analysis and interpretation.

Dairy Business by Cooperatives- 26-28 April, 2023

A three-day Online Training Program on Dairy Business by Cooperatives was successfully organized by LINAC for Leadership and Personnel of Primary Level Cooperatives of Rajasthan. A total of 19 participants attended this training program. The program was organized to enable the participants to describe an overview of dairy sector in India and explain the cost benefit analysis and revenue models of dairy farm.



Team Building- 28 April, 2023

A one-day Online Training Program on Team Building was organized for 49 officials from Cooperatives and other Organizations of Gujarat, U.P. Rajasthan. This was the first of its kind program organized by LINAC since its inception. The program was organized to enable participants to explain the definition of a team, process and various strategies involved in team building.


Communication Skills- 31 May, 2023

Financial Management in Cooperatives- 27 June, 2023




Online Training Programs/ Sessions conducted in collaboration with Ministry of Cooperation (MoC)





Online Training Programs on Role of Women Directors in Governance and Business Development in Cooperatives/SHGs


