#### **About NCDC**

The National Cooperative Development Corporation has the unique distinction of being the sole statutory organization under the Federal Ministry of Cooperation, Government of India. Set up under an Act of the Parliament in 1962, it functions as an apex financial and developmental institution devoted to the purpose of planning and promoting programs for the production, processing, marketing, storage, export and import of agricultural produce, foodstuffs, industrial goods, livestock, certain other commodities and services on cooperative principles. It supports cooperatives in diverse fields apart from agriculture and allied sectors. It is an ISO 9001:2015 compliant organization.

Headquartered at New Delhi, NCDC serves every State and Union Territory in India through its own network of 18 regional offices spread across India. NCDC has assisted various programs benefiting more than one lakh cooperatives in diverse sectors such as micro-finance, women's cooperatives, IT services including computerization, value enhancement processing, agriculture, organic farming, farm mechanization, horticulture, dairying, fisheries, poultry, sheep and goat, storage, jute, tea, cold chain, transport, processing, consumer and retail stores, agriculture inputs supply, hospitals, transport, hospitality, brand promotion, marketing, and, above all custom made training programs for different stakeholders.

#### **LINAC**

NCDC set up its own training institution in 1985 through a World Bank project. Over the years, the training institute has become a major facility for training the cooperative sector professionals in India and abroad. Building upon the strength of the training institution and to promote research and development in the cooperative sector, the Government of India upgraded the institute with a broader mandate for training, research and consultancy and renamed it as the Laxmanrao Inamdar National Academy for Cooperative Research and Development (LINAC) in February, 2018.

LINAC conducts training programs under different sectors/ functional areas namely International Programs, Integrated Cooperative Development Projects (ICDPs), Skill Upgradation Program in IT Application, Management Development Program for Agri Produce Marketing Cooperatives, MDP for Women Cooperatives, Dairy Cooperatives, Organizational Development, General Management/ Human Resource Management, Cooperative Banking, Farmer Producer Organizations related Programs.

The Institution in its journey over the years has built up functional collaboration with premier national and international institutions and organizations like Centre for International Cooperation and Training in Agricultural Banking (CICTAB), International Cooperative Alliance (ICA), Network for Development of Agricultural Cooperatives in Asia and the Pacific (NEDAC), Asia Pacific Rural and Agricultural Credit Association (APRACA), Vaikunth Mehta National Institute of Cooperative Management (VAMNICOM), National Horticulture Board (NHB), National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development (NABARD), Warehousing Development and Regulatory Authority (WDRA), National Institute of Agricultural Marketing (NIAM), National Institute of Agricultural Extension Management (MANAGE), National Federation of Urban Cooperative Banks (NAFCUB), Agricultural and Processed Food Products Export Development Authority (APEDA), Tribal Cooperative Marketing Development Federation of India (TRIFED), Spices Board of India and National Productivity Council (NPC) for capacity development interventions.

NCDC has MoUs with ICAR spanning about 100 Institutions across the country and with more than 15 Agriculture Universities to promote inter alia capacity building and training to strengthen the management in cooperatives.

LINAC is designated as Nodal Training Institution at central level for FPOs registered under Co- operative Societies Act and promoted by NCDC. LINAC is also associated as a training partner under PMFME, other schemes of MoFPI and Department of Fisheries, GoI for capacity development of personnel of Cooperative Societies/ Federations, entrepreneurs and other stakeholders in the food processing and fisheries sector.

LINAC has established first of its kind LINAC-NCDC Fisheries Business Incubation Centre (LIFIC) under PMMSY, Gol. LIFIC was inaugurated by Hon'ble Union Minister of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying, Gol. LIFIC would extend relevant incubation support to young professionals, entrepreneurs, progressive fish farmers, fisheries based industries and other activities who will operate in collaboration with Fisheries cooperatives at various levels namely primary, district, state, multi-state or at national level federations. The first LIFIC training program was conducted for ten incubatees from four states, during 2021-22.

In order to strengthen the cooperative movement, LINAC-NCDC undertook fifteen (15) sectoral consultative discussions on Coir, Agro and Food Processing, Cold-Chain, Consumer and Retail, Storage, Dairy, Fruits and Vegetables, Fisheries, Hospitals and Health Care, Labour, Livestock, Marketing, Sugar, Textile and Women cooperatives, through VC mode in September, 2021. Several eminent resource persons from the Central Government, experts and representatives from cooperative sector and senior officials from NCDC participated in the event.

Drawing inspiration from address by Hon'ble Union Home and Cooperation Minister, Mr. Amit Shah, on 25 September, 2021 at National Cooperative Conference in New Delhi, NCDC conceived the idea of organizing a **Chintan Shibir** on an International Good Practices Platform for Cooperatives. Mr. Ariel Guarco, President of the International Cooperative Alliance visited NCDC Head office in New Delhi and mentioned that to translate the idea of the Union Home and Cooperation Minister into reality, ICA would be willing to work with NCDC (an associate member of ICA) through its Asia Pacific regional office (ICA-AP). NCDC has identified the LINAC as the nodal point for collaboration with ICA-AP.

In this regard, LINAC-NCDC and ICA-AP signed an agreement intending to assimilate and develop further on the core strengths, experience and institutional objectives of the respective parties in the interest of advancement of research, study, documentation and training for development of the cooperative sectors. On the occasion, a policy recommendation handbook on SAHAKAR PRAGYA Good Practices for Cooperatives was released. This is to help cooperatives in India and abroad to innovate and adopt best practices not only to stay competitive but also to distinguish themselves as successful commercial entities.

The Handbook was jointly released by ICA-AP President Dr. Chandra Pal Singh Yadav and NCUI President Mr. Dileep Sanghani in the presence of Mr. Sundeep Kumar Nayak, MD, NCDC and Mr. D.N. Thakur, National President, Sahakar Bharati.

In the light of the clarion call given by Hon'ble Prime Minister to Double the Farmers' Income, NCDC embarked upon its SAHAKAR-22 framework under which SAHAKAR PRAGYA related activities are focused on capacity development of primary level cooperatives across the country. NCDC officials have visited and contacted more than 14000 primary cooperatives across the country since April 2019. Based on its experience and core competence of training cooperatives since 1985, and also in the light of new flagship programs of the Government of India, LINAC has expanded its training horizon to meet the needs of primary level

cooperatives.

The Academy, during the year 2021-22 has conducted 97 programs for 5092 participants. Cumulatively, around 38164 personnel have participated in more than 1114 training programs/ workshops/ webinars organized by LINAC. Out of these programs, 150 programs, attended by 4831 personnel were conducted under the Government of India assisted Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojna (RKVY) Capacity Building Project.

LINAC has its core team of specialists and resource groups, broadly divided into eleven operational areas. Adopting the contours of the National Training Policy of the Government of India as a systematic approach of training, LINAC conducts Training Needs Analysis (TNA) and designs programs based on client requirements, and implements them with basic tenets of pedagogy. LINAC has established an in-house design studio for production of guidance/ training videos and developing study materials for offline and online trainings.

LINAC is housed in a highly accessible and sprawling five-acre wi-fi enabled campus on the Delhi-Jaipur expressway near the Indira Gandhi International Airport, New Delhi. It has a state of the art infrastructure which includes air conditioned plenary halls, syndicate rooms, auditorium, library, air conditioned hostel rooms with attached bath / toilet and dining facilities. LINAC has upgraded its infrastructure to virtual classrooms and is running e-learning courses and webinars. Other facilities include yoga hall, indoor and outdoor games and mini gymnasium.

LINAC has set up 18 Regional Training Centres (RTCs) across the country. The focus of these RTCs is on developing professionalism in primary level cooperatives in agriculture and allied sectors. These centres mainly run different programs on management of primary level cooperatives of various sectors. During the year 2021-22, these training centres conducted a total of 159 programs, including 72 training programs under PMMSY, which have benefitted 14835 personnel of cooperative sector. Cumulatively, these RTCs have trained 18946 personnel through 232 training programs. List of 18 LINAC-RTCs are enclosed at Annexure I.

LINAC, Gurugram and LINAC RTCs also conduct online courses depending on clients' requirements. RTCs shall be actively associated in implementing the capacity building programs for the various central sector schemes.
