Sub: NCDC Sponsored Scheme for the promotion, development and financing of Industrial Cooperatives – Regarding.

Sir.

As you may be aware, the National Cooperative Development Corporation's Act has been amended with effect from 16th September, 2002 (notified in the Gazette of India, Extraordinary, Part-II Section –1 on 16th August, 2002) enabling the Corporation, inter-alia, to extend financial assistance for promotion and development of "Industrial Cooperatives".

- 2. In consonance with the provision of the Act, assistance will be provided to industrial Cooperatives for production, processing, marketing, storage, import and export of "industrial goods".
- 3. As per the Act, "industrial goods" would mean the products of industrial cooperatives or cottage and village industries or products of allied industries in the rural areas and include any handicrafts or rural crafts.

4. The scheme for development of Industrial Cooperatives will broadly cover the following:

- Establishment of industrial worksheds/units including plant & machinery for production/fabrication/assembling/processing of industrial goods, handicrafts, rural crafts & other products.
- Expansion/modernization/renovation of existing industrial cooperative units.
- Construction of marketing infrastructure including showrooms/ warehouses/ transport vehicles etc.
- Strengthening of share capital base/margin money assistance and working capital to industrial cooperatives for business operations.

5. Procedure for availing financial assistance

- (i) The application for assistance shall be sent to NCDC in the prescribed format alongwith a Detailed Project Report (DPR).
- (ii) The proposal for financial assistance shall be dully recommended by the respective State Govt.
- (iii) In respect of multi-state cooperative societies, NCDC can also consider to provide assistance on the basis of mortgage of assets of the society.
- (iv) Release of assistance from NCDC will be made in accordance with the terms & conditions stipulated in the sanction letter.
- 6. Pattern of Assistance for above activities is enclosed at Annex-I. The quantum of assistance for eligible activities will be determined on viability considerations and merit of each case. Cooperatives may avail Term Loan and other assistance from the NCDC by dovetailing different schemes, invogue/to be introduced by the Govt. of India and different State Govts, to reap optimal benefits. NCDC loan shall be for a period of 8 years repayable in equal annual installments. There shall be a moratorium of 1 year on the repayment of principal in respect of term loan. There shall, however, be no moratorium on repayment of investment loan and payment of interest.

7. Rate of Interest

The loan assistance shall carry such rate of interest as may be prevailing at the time of actual release of funds. Present effective rates of interest are as under:

- 9. Accordingly, I am to request that the scheme for development of Industrial cooperatives may be brought to the notice of concerned departments. Suitable proposals may be formulated in the prescribed application formats and recommended to the NCDC for availing financial assistance. Eligible industrial cooperative societies can also avail direct funding from NCDC as per the guidelines already circulated by the Corporation.
